GPA Cancellation Policy

Your use fee will be due when of making the reservation. No refunds will be given for lack of attendance or inclement weather. If the cancellation is requested more than fourteen days prior to the event, 25% of the base fee will be retained as a cancellation fee (equal to \$22.50 per day for a weekday rental and \$45.00 for Saturday, Sunday or Holiday rental) No refund will be given if the cancellation is requested any time within the fourteen days prior to the rental.

You may pay by cash, credit card (Visa/MasterCard or Discover), or in person at our Visitors Center. Checks or money order should be made payable to COLORADO STATE PARKS. All mailed materials should be sent to the Boyd Lake State Park address.

PLEASE NOTE: The cancellation policy is **25%** of picnic fee if cancelled greater than 14 days. If cancelled within 14 days of event then cancel fee is **100%** of fee.

Refunds are strictly at the Park Manager's discretion.

If it is feasible you may be able to reschedule for an **open** date if there is a **severe** emergency to your group, or if a severe weather emergency occurs the day of the picnic. Please be aware that there is no guarantee the date can be rescheduled. Rescheduling is strictly at the Park Manager's discretion.

Mariner Point Group Picnic Area

Mariner Point Group Picnic Area

Mariner Point Group Picnic Area (GPA) is located within Boyd Lake State Park. This popular covered shelter sits atop a small ridge overlooking Boyd Lake and the Marina.

The Mariner Point GPA has picnic tables which can accommodate approximately 200 people. With expansive counter space, a stainless steel sink, and 2 large charcoal grills, barbecuing is a breeze! A

fireplace is also within the shelter, along with electrical lighting and outlets.

Mariner Point also boasts it's own sand volleyball court and horseshoe pits! (Please provide your own volleyballs and horseshoes.) The kids will be excited when they see the playground complete with a tower spiral slide, swings, observation deck, and a covered shoot-slide. Innovative compost restrooms are located next to the sheltered area and a private boat dock is also available on site. Fishing is allowed with a current state license.

Reservations are accepted up to 180 days in advance for mid May-mid September. It is available from 9:00am to 9:00pm. The fee is due at the time of reservation.. We accept cash, check or Visa/ MasterCard/Discover. See Back Page for the GPA Cancellation Policy.

To make a reservation print the Rental Agreement found on at Colorado State Parks website. Choose Boyd Lake from the list of parks, under the Group Picnic Area tab, and submit with payment via mail, in person, email or fax.

All vehicles are required to have a valid State Parks Pass or Alternative Pass Agreement voucher .

Alternate Pass Agreement

An Alternate pass agreement allows individuals that rent the GPA to create and distribute vouchers to all people who will be attending the event. When a vehicle enters the park for the event, they will give the voucher to the entrance station attendant in return for a daily park pass. If the vehicle occupants do not provide a voucher, they will be required to purchase a park pass. At the end of the event, the responsible party will submit payment (cash, check with ID, MasterCard, Visa or Discover) for all vouchers collected. A copy of the voucher being used must be submitted in advance for approval. The passes must have the words **BOYD LAKE STATE PARK** and the **DATE OF ENTRY** located on them. The individual submitting the Alternate pass agreement is responsible for informing all members of their group about this arrangement and ensuring full payment of the applicable entry fees.

GPA Regulations

The following regulations apply to the Group Picnic Area:

- ✦ All vehicles and trailers including BBQs, catering vehicles and delivery units must remain in the parking lot at all times. Vehicles are **NOT** permitted under the shelter or on the sidewalk for any reason.
- ✦ 3.2% alcohol only
- ✦ All vehicles must display a valid park pass.



Private Playground at GPA

- ✦ No fireworks.
- ✦ Pets must remain on a leash.
- ✦ Swimming is prohibited, except at the Swim Beach.

Please note that upon arrival and at exit the responsible party will perform a walk through with a Park Officer to check the conditions of the premises.
