Camper Services Building

Services Include: camper registration, park information, camp store with grocery and gift items, restrooms, coin-operated showers, coin-operated laundry, playground, pay phone, activity room and educational displays. Office hours vary, use self-service for permits when station is closed.

Full-Hookup Campgrounds: \$24.00 per night

Raptor Glen Grove, Gobbler Grove, Swift Puma Heights, and the Meadow Group Campgrounds
Sites include electrical, water, and sewer hookups, tent pad, picnic table, emergency water hydrant, and fire ring.

Walk-In Tent Sites: \$16.00 per night

Sites 29-34 in Swift Puma Heights and sites 45-48 in the Meadow
Sites include tent pad, picnic table, emergency water hydrant, and fire ring
Walk-in sites have one parking space big enough to hold one passenger vehicle.

Please note that there will be a \$2 fee added to the daily camping price during high season from May 1st thru September 30th.

All vehicles must have a valid daily or Annual Colorado State Park Pass for every day the vehicle is in the park.
This fee is in addition to the camping fees.

For the individual campsites (1 to 48), camping fees are \$21/night (Full Hookup) and \$13/night (Tent Sites) Sunday through Thursday nights (excluding holidays) for valid Colorado Aspen Leaf holders.

Reservation Information

Take the worry out of your stay; make sure you have a campsite with a reservation!

Reservations are strongly recommended. Campgrounds often fill to capacity on the weekends from Memorial Day through Labor Day. Weekdays through the summer are also very busy. After reservations, sites at the park are first-come-first-served. Sites purchased at the park cannot be guaranteed for more than two (2) days.
