PUBLIC COMMENTS

Re: Motorized Use of Steamboat Lake State Park's "Poverty Bar Trail" and Snowmobile Access to Routt National Forest

Bryan Heselbach provided Board members and Colorado State Parks staff with an information packet containing maps of Hans Peak Village, documentation and letters of support. Bryan Heselbach and Shirley Stocks voiced opposition to motorized vehicles on Placer Trail due to the close proximity of the trail to Hans Peak Village. Although some residents of Hans Peak Village use snowmobiles within the Village, a number of residents were opposed to use of snowmobiles on the trail.

Doug Button commented via telephone conferencing noting Routt National Forest is already being accessed by snowmobiles. Boundaries were not clear and his land was accessed to get to the Forest. Poverty Bar Trail provides the most direct and safest trail to the Forest.

Mr. Heselbach indicated the residents of Hans Peak Village would like more time before consideration of motorized access to the Forest is approved by the Board, so they can explore other options.

PURPOSE: To award the bid for the shooting center concession at Cherry Creek State Park.


